Those of us working to develop the plan genuinely hope that



This month - Listed Buildings and Monuments



The National Heritage List for England is the only official, up to date, register of all nationally protected historic buildings and sites in England and is now available via the Internet.

The web site contains information on listed buildings, scheduled monuments, protected wrecks, registered parks and gardens, and battlefields.

To explore the listed buildings map go to www.historicengland.org.uk and click on the link to “Explore the listed building map” type in your post code and up pops Newton.

Gathering Information

As part of our village Newton Neighbourhood Plan (NNP) Kate Waterworth, a member of the NNP committee, organised an evening for the village community to come together to make a start on understanding and recording the ecological profile of the village.

After an introduction Joanne Atkins (Wildlife Learning Officer, Suffolk Wildlife Trust) led a group on a tour of the playing field where they were given the opportunity to draw, record or photograph what they saw and helped start build up a picture of the biodiversity around our village.

Once complete this and similar studies will form an integral part of the NNP and help focus where the most appropriate sites might be for future developments.
